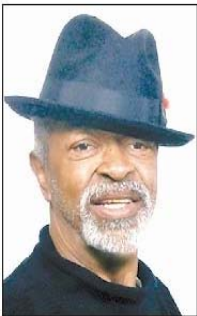

COLD CASE



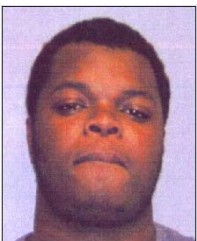
Crime Stoppers of Sangamon/Menard Counties is seeking information concerning these unsolved homicides from **2004**:



EDWIN DILLARD (age 66, black male) was found murdered in his apartment at 1129 E. Monroe on August 3, 2004. He suffered massive blood loss from a cut to his neck. Neighbors reported speaking with him at 7 P.M. He had left the door to his apartment open, but it was closed around 9:30 P.M. Police were called to the apartment at 11:35 P.M, where Dillard was found face down in a pool of his own blood.



The body of **HENRY WALLACE** (age 26, black male) was found in a wooded area behind 1920 Witchazel on February 15, 2006. Wallace, who had not been seen since October 17, 2004, died from gunshot wounds.



On December 5, 2004, at 4 A.M., **ANDRE AYERS** (aka "Yumpy") was driving a friend's red Navigator and was the lead car in a procession of cars leaving Mac's Lounge. Ayers stopped his vehicle near 13th and Cedar, got out and went back to talk to people stopped in the car behind him. He was then shot by an occupant of another car stopped further back in the line of cars. Ayers was dropped off at St. John Hospital's emergency room, where he died from a gunshot wound to the neck.
